

Emergency Drill Requirements

- NYSED Requires
- 8 Evacuations (6 before December 31st, 2 between January 1st and the end of the year)
 - 4 Lockdown drills
 - A written notice of the drill requirements will be provided





Building level Security

- Contracted Security Officers at Elementary and Middle School
 - Frequent perimeter checks
 - Monitor parking lots and areas around the building
 - Visitor management system
- EMHCS Student Support Liaisons at Middle and High School
 - Intricate part of the School day to day operations
 - Support Admin, staff and students throughout the day
 - Support arrival and dismissal procedures
- Exit's monitored and secured during the day
- Relationship with RPD and Visits to Campus
- Staff wear Identification visible




